

PROCEDURES FOR ACCESSING RESTRICTED AREAS

In order to access Levels D and C, ILL7 and ILL 22, you must be in possession of:

- A badge
- An electronic dosimeter (DMC) in good working order
- A passive dosimeter.

The badge and dosimeters will be given to you by the security staff on Level C when you arrive.

The items you receive

Badge



DMC
(electronic dosimeter)



Passive dosimeter



The turnstile and its equipment



Access control unit
Badge reader
Turnstile
Status lights



Light 3 (turnstile state):
-Red: locked
-Green: unlocked
Light 2 (DMC state):
-Off: DMC not detected
-Red: DMC faulty
-Green: DMC ok
Light 1 (badge):
-Green: passage authorised
-Red: passage not authorised

Procedure for entering restricted areas

At the turnstile place your badge on the badge reader and bring your DMC to within 30 cm of the control unit.

- If you have all the necessary permissions, the badge light (1) should turn to green.
- If your DMC is working properly, the DMC light (2) should turn to green after a few seconds.

The turnstile light (3) will then turn green; the turnstile will unlock and you can advance.

Access refused

- If you don't have the permissions you need to enter the area, the badge light (1) will turn to red.
 - ➔ Get the badge checked by the security staff at the Level C entrance.
- If the DMC is out of order, the DMC light (2) will turn red, or not light up at all.
 - ➔ Try presenting the DMC to the control unit again.
 - ➔ If the problem persists, get the DMC checked by the security staff at the Level C entrance.

Tip: Check that everything works as soon as you receive your badge and DMC, at an access point close to the Level C security post (Level C or ILL 7 depending on your rights).
