DATA DOIs & ADDRESS

Anyone publishing results based on data from the ILL must cite the DOI corresponding to the ILL beamtime proposal(s) in the references section of the publication.

When publishing without data from beamtime, make sure your article contains the full ILL address of (at least) one author, to secure it gets registered as an ILL publication.
